Exercise A: Sampling Activity

Session 2: Research Design and Sampling Frameworks

Your organization has been asked to conduct an EGRA in the country of Readistan. Various stakeholders are interested in learning the following:

- Reading levels for all 6 grades of public government schools
- Information as to whether children in private schools are doing better than children in public schools
- Literacy levels for non-formal schools
- Information on how children in all 5 regions of the country are doing
- Insight into how children are performing in 3 languages

Discuss the following:

- 1. What is the purpose of the EGRA activity based on the information desired?
- 2. What are the research questions?
- 3. What is the sampling frame based on the information desired by different stakeholders? How many pupils would need to be sampled and assessed?
- 4. Are the research questions and resulting sample of students needed realistic? If not, what would you propose to gather, and why?
- 5. A new reading intervention program will soon be launched as a pilot in two regions. Can the EGRA you plan to conduct be used to evaluate the project?
